Mission: Demand Manager helps Government, industry and commercial partners to realise the benefits of sustainable energy and water through informed partnerships.

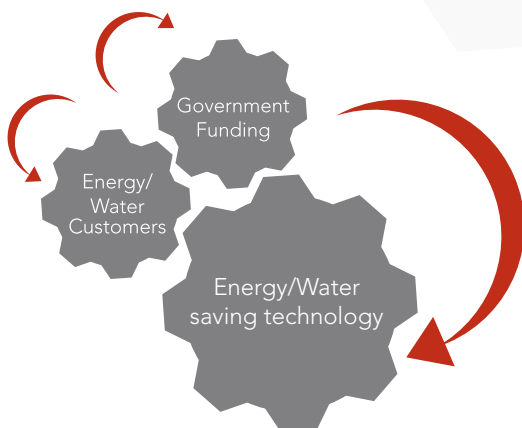

Demand Management may include a reduction in the quantity being consumed in order to reduce greenhouse emissions. It may also include changes to the pattern of consumption, particularly electricity, in order to reduce the impact on the electricity network at times of peak consumption. Reducing energy and water consumption in the commercial and private sector can often lead to significant financial savings as well as improved environmental performance.
